## Annotated internet bibliography of lesson plan sites

Links to lesson plan sites are recorded in the table below in addition to ranking data and annotations. Quantity of sites is emphasized rather than quality of the lesson plans. This is intentional and is motivated by several considerations:

- I anticipate more difficulty finding <u>any</u> lesson plan on a particular topic than finding a good lesson plan. This is a side effect of striving for an integrated curriculum in which subjects like social studies spin off into math and science lessons.
- An otherwise good lesson plan may not captivate my students or be optimal for my classroom. I would likely back up the best lesson with ideas from other lessons, especially if I anticipate needing to make accommodations for exceptional students. This requires more sources.
- Many sites offer user contributed lesson plans that vary widely in quality. Only the lesson plan I'm looking for needs to be of high quality, not all of them.
- Web sites are very dynamic and I would rather keep track of a link and check up on it periodically than not include it in the list. Data such as number of links or content such as a single especially good lesson plan can change overnight. I did drop some sites that did little more than repackage links to other sites.
- I would rather judge quality based on actual use of a site rather than an anticipated need long before it materializes.
- The list may eventually be added to a database to drive a meta search or web mining project for which completeness is important.

The rating system (ratio column) is based on the "batting average" for a site. If I visit the site and find a good lesson plan, hit is incremented; if none is found, then miss is incremented. The table can be copied into Excel and sorted by ratio to find the good sites or by hit+miss=visits to find sites that might not have been given enough chances.

Data in this table can easily be rewritten in a more conventional paragraph form even though it makes comparison between sites more difficult. Here is an example:

A to Z Teacher Stuff provides lesson plans for students across the entire grade range (pre-kindergarten through 12) and spectrum of subjects (16 of them). Subjects are conveniently accessed from a single web page requiring no navigation of a confusing topic hierarchy, but resulting in perhaps overly general headings. Lesson plans are located by using the search function based on keyword and/or grade level or by browsing first by subject and then by grade level (or the other way around). Results show a lesson plan title, helpful description, grade level, and rating. The lesson plans are contributed by users via a web form, which results in a standardized format, but widely varying quality. Some lesson plans are accessed via links to external sites and can therefore have unrelated formats. One very annoying aspect of the site is the advertising which "features" distracting animated gifs and even worse, popups. The present rating for this site is 0.500 resulting from one hit and one miss.
